

Request for Qualifications (RFQ)

The South Seminole North Orange County Wastewater Transmission Authority (Authority) invites qualifications data and expression of interest for "Professional Engineering and Extension of Staff Services" from qualified engineering firms. "Engineering and Extension of Staff Services" shall include, but not limited to engineering services for the survey, design, engineering and construction inspection services of wastewater infrastructure, maintenance and update of the wastewater hydraulic modeling, management of the air release valve program, management of the utility locates program per Sunshine State One Call legislation, and management of the infiltration and inflow reduction program per the Authority's "Enabling Act."

Selected firms will sign a three (3)-years contract to provide the Authority with continuing services as required for various projects.

Firms requesting consideration shall provide the Authority with three (3) sets of information data pertaining to their ability to perform the types of services required. All firms shall have proper authorization to transact business in the State of Florida from the Secretary of the State of the Florida Department of Professional Regulation. Any letter of response submitted pursuant to this notice must include the following:

- Name and address of responsible officers of the firm.
- Resumes of principals and staff of the firm.
- Firm organizational chart.
- List of five (5) projects completed in the past five years indicating proficiency in similar area disciplines as described in the first paragraph. Please, limit one page per project.
